



## Albert Hixon

July 12, 1925 - January 8, 2017

Albert "Tim" Hixon age 91 of Oklahoma City, passed away Sunday, Jan. 8, 2017 in Lexington, OK. Tim was born on July 12, 1925 in Kingfisher, OK. He was one of six children born to Albert Rush Hixon and Ethel Mae (Hickson). Tim grew up in Choctaw where he attended school. As a teenager he began working for Wilson & Co. in OKC, loading packaged meat. However in 1945, during WWII, the U.S. Army needed him, so he proudly served his country for 1 ½ years and was honorably discharged on Jan. 15, 1947. While a member of the church he served as an Usher and as a Money Counter on the Finance Committee. After he retired from Wilsons & Co. Tim and Norma enjoyed traveling with the Real People Sunday School Class. He also kept busy mowing his yard and the neighbor's yard, going on weekend camping trips and camping vacations. One of his favorite past-time was watching old western and wrestling on TV. Because of their failing health, Tim and Norma moved into the Meadow lake Assisted Living Center in 2013. Only recently did he moved to the Lexington-Purcell area to be close to daughter, Sherre and her family.
