Allen Biggs, age 82, of Purcell, Oklahoma, passed away on Friday, January 2, 2026. Floyd Allen Biggs was born on October 6, 1943, in Piedmont, Oklahoma, the second of four children born to George Floyd Biggs and Edna Virginia (Harrison) Biggs. He was raised in Piedmont and attended school there, graduating with the Piedmont Wildcats Class of 1961. Allen proudly answered the call to serve his country by enlisting in the United States Marine Corps.
