



Amos Weldon Tolbert

February 21, 1932 - November 26, 2013

Weldon Tolbert, aged 81, beloved father, grandfather and great-grandfather, passed away Tuesday, November 26th, 2013 at his home in Mustang, Oklahoma. He was born February 21st, 1932 in Everton, Missouri. He was the youngest of three sons born to Amos Tolbert and Mabel (Owens) Tolbert. Weldon grew up on a farm in Southwest Missouri and graduated from Greenfield High School in 1950. After graduation, he joined the U.S. Air Force and proudly served his country during the Korean Conflict. While in the service Weldon married Geraldine Hudson, the love of his life, on November 16th, 1951. After he was discharged in 1954 he and Gerry made their home in Oklahoma City, where they raised their three children, David, Karen and Mike.
