Arthur Edmond Rollings, age 74 of Noble passed away Sunday, January 20, 2013 at Norman Regional Hospital. He was born on October 26, 1938 in Blanchard, OK. He was the oldest child of five children born to John Thomas Rollings and Eunice Victoria (Mayo) Rollings. Arthur grew up in the Johnsonville community North of Byars, OK and attended Asher schools.
