Billy Faught Sr. age 91 of Lexington, passed away on January 13, 2023. Billy Earl Faught was born on January 2, 1932 in Tipton, Oklahoma, the third of ten children born to Irland Otto Faught and Bertha Mae Faught (Allen). His family eventually settled in Brownfield, Texas where he attended Wellman High School and graduated with the Union class of 1950.
