Bobby Carl Castle, age 88 of Okla. City, passed away Monday, November 23, 2020. He was born June 20, 1932 in Mangum, Oklahoma, to James William Victor Castle and Esther Pearl (Nikkel) Castle. He was raised in the City View Community near Mangum, and graduated high school there.
