Born in Oklahoma City on May 16, 1958, Brenda Kay Solomon was the beloved daughter of Ralmon and Fredella (Fisher) Thompson. Raised and educated in Stroud, Oklahoma, she was a standout athlete, playing basketball all four years and graduating from Stroud High School in 1977.

Brenda was baptized into the General Assembly and Church of the Firstborn on July 7, 1973, by Bro. Lewis Wright. Her life was a testament to her faith and her commitment to serving others, often expressed through acts of service, cleaning, and cooking, with her famous meatloaf being a favorite.

At the age of 24, Brenda married Darrell Solomon, and together they moved to Oklahoma City, where they raised two daughters. She was devoted to ensuring that Tiara and Tiffany grew up surrounded by brethren and knowing the faith. She instilled in them the values of hard work and dedication.

Brenda's tireless efforts extended to caring for others, babysitting, and cleaning homes.

Her greatest joy came from spending time with family and friends. As a grandmother, or "MiMi," she cherished every moment and embraced her role with enthusiasm, especially in supporting her grandchildren's sports endeavors, where she took her sideline coaching seriously.

Brenda passed away peacefully in her home at the age of 66 on Thursday, August 1, surrounded by her loved ones, just as she had hoped.

She is preceded in death by her parents, Ralmon and Fredella Thompson, and her sister, Dianna Greenfield.

She is survived by her daughters, Tiara (Eric) Armenta and Tiffany (Alicia) Solomon; her grandchildren, Jazlene and Zerek Armenta; her brother, Fred Thompson; as well as many nephews, nieces, and a host of loving relatives and friends.
