



## Bryan Kyle Cantrell

September 5, 1962 - April 22, 2022

Kyle Cantrell, age 59 of Grove, passed away unexpectedly on Friday, April 22, 2022. Bryan Kyle Cantrell was born September 5, 1962 in Thomas, OK, the middle child of three children of Bob and Glenda (Capps) Cantrell. Kyle spent his early years in Weatherford, Elk City, Wanette and later in Norman. By chance, Kyle and some friends were hanging out at Turner Falls, and ended up dragging Main St. in Purcell later that evening. It was July 4, 1979, and the day he met Vicky Boydston.
