David Wayne McCaskill, age 59 of Norman, passed away unexpectedly Wednesday, June 22, 2022. David was born December 22, 1962, in Purcell, Oklahoma, the 5th of 6 children born to Bobby Francis McCaskill and Melba Rahe (Cariker) McCaskill. He was raised in Purcell and attended school there, graduating with the Dragon Class of 1982. It was said that David was a "water bug" and would do anything to be in it, and the lake was his happy place. He enjoyed visits to the beach and looked forward to planning beach vacations. He loved a good joke, pulling pranks, and never took himself too

seriously. He was a wonderful father, grandfather, brother, uncle, and a good friend. He will be dearly missed!
