Don Looman, age 64 of Paoli, passed away Sunday, March 15, 2015 at his home. Don Edward Looman was born February 26, 1951 in Purcell, OK. He was one of three sons born to Elvas Lorn Looman and Ruby Sue (Poe) Looman. Don was raised in Purcell and attended Purcell schools graduating with the class of 1969.
