Doris Ewing passed away peacefully on Tuesday, May 27, 2025 at the age of 91. Her last wish was that she wanted to meet her infant great-grandchildren before she left this life. Those three newest arrivals graced her bedside in her final days. She spoke often of her three sons, her seven grandchildren and her four great-grandchildren.

Preceded in death by her husband of nearly 70 years, Wyman F. Ewing, M.D., she spent her final days looking forward to seeing him again in the afterlife.

Born and raised in Oklahoma City, she graduated with a degree in Music from the Oklahoma College for Women. Married in 1954, she moved with her new husband to St. Louis so he could attend medical school. She worked as a music teacher during those years of school, then moved back to Oklahoma to start a family. Feeling like they needed to move quickly building the family because she was “getting old” at age 25, the couple had three sons in three years. She spent the next 20 years being a full-time mother.

An accomplished pianist, she played for over 30 years at her church during weekly worship services. She was known as an excellent accompanist and was frequently requested by both choirs and soloists.

During retirement, the couple traveled the world and spent time at their cabin

in San Isabel, Co and townhome in Surprise, AZ.

She is survived by her sons Dave (Crystal), Steve (Christina), and Jim (Crystie), seven grandchildren, and four great-grandchildren.
