Former Oklahoma resident DORIS RAE DOWDY COONCE PROCTOR, 81, went to be with the Lord on October 19, 2016, at Deaconess Medical Center in Spokane, Wash. Mrs. Proctor was born March 27, 1935, in Dougherty, OK to the late Oren Turner and Julia Mae Atchley Dowdy. She had an unwavering faith in God which started at a young age and stayed with her always.
