Dorothy Anderson, age 80 of Purcell, passed away Friday, December 30, 2022. Dorothy Jo Mantooth was born July 30, 1942 in Purcell, the 4th of 5 daughters born to John Russell Mantooth and Etta Roberta Mantooth. Dorothy was raised in Purcell and attended school there, graduating with the Dragon Class of 1960. After graduation, Dorothy worked for Western Electric for a short time, and as a receptionist for C.L. Boyd in Oklahoma City. During that time her sister Sharon introduced her to a young man from Wayne named Lloyd Wayne Anderson. They were the perfect couple and the rest as they say, is history. Dorothy and Lloyd were married on July 7, 1967 in Okla. City. By 1970, they had settled in Purcell where they raised their children, son Paul and daughters, Teka and Shana. Dorothy worked tirelessly as a homemaker, caring and providing for their every need. She stayed active in her community by volunteering with organizations such as 4-H and the Junior Miss Pageant, and also operated a custom framing business for several years in Purcell. She volunteered at the Purcell Hospital whenever needed, and was an active member of the Hospital Auxiliary for more than 42 years. Whatever activities her children were involved in, Dorothy made it a point to be involved. As a grandmother, she loved to go and support her grandchildren in various activities, musicals and sports, always standing out as their biggest fan. She was a member of the World

Organization of China Painters (WOCP), where she held several offices over the years including President. As an artist she often served as a demonstrator and teacher, and judged for many years at the State Fair. She was a woman of great faith and longtime member of the 9th & Pierce Church of Christ. She loved serving others and will be dearly missed!
