Florene Wyatt Lobaugh died peacefully May 24, 2021 in Oklahoma City at the age of 106. Florene was born September 29, 1914 to Harry Dempsey and Sylvia Irene (McKee) Adams in Smithville, Oklahoma. Florene graduated from Bowlegs, OK high school and graduated with a Bachelor of Science degree from the University of Oklahoma in 1938. She married Leon Robert Wyatt in 1934 in Norman, OK.
