



George Hank Talley

George "Hank" Talley age 84 of Newcastle, OK was born August 14, 1929 on a farm southeast of Newcastle. Hank was accepted into the arms of his Lord on Thursday, May 1, 2014 after a short illness with leukemia. He was the 8th child of nine children born to Henry Clifton Talley and Ethel Owen. Hank grew up in Newcastle and attended Newcastle High School graduating in 1947. He spent four years in the U. S. Air Force from 1951-1955.
