Harold Ray Perry, age 77, of Noble passed away in his home on Wednesday, April 13, 2022. He was born May 28, 1944 in Washington, Oklahoma, to Ernest Hayes Perry and Bessie I. (Burns) Perry. He was raised in the Goins community west of Purcell and graduated with the Dragon Class of 1962.
