Harry Sidney Phillips age 85 of Newcastle, passed away at his home on Friday, November 15, 2013 following a battle with cancer. He was born December 14, 1927 in Goldsby, Oklahoma. He was the 2nd child of three children born to William "Bill" Edward Phillips and Audrey Bertha (Patton) Phillips. Harry grew up in the Newcastle community helping his father on the family farm. During the years that his daughter Lauri was growing up he proudly supported her in all of her school activities. Even farming full time he never missed one of Lauri's basketball games. Harry was a faithful Christian man and was a member of the Newcastle First Baptist Church for over 45 years. For many of those years he served as usher/greeter and on various church committees. He was chosen to serve as a member on the McClain County ASCS Board for many years because of his farming abilities. He will be remembered as a wonderful
