Henry retired from Conoco after a long career in the oil industry. Throughout his career he traveled all over the country. He retired in Hattiesburg where his daughter married and started her family. He attended every birthday party, sporting event, recital, and school program. One of Henry's greatest joys was being "Gampa" to not only his four
