Janice Kay (Wilson) Haswell entered heaven on June 28, 2026. Janice was born on February 19, 1944 to Orville Leon (O.L.) & Mary Gladys (Layton) Wilson. She was a tiny baby girl born to a family of three boys passionate about race cars. Her parents were faithful to take their family to church at First Baptist Moore where she surrendered her life to Christ on March 16, 1952 at the age of 8.
