Jeffrey Craig Chilvers, age 38 of Lexington, passed away Friday, April 9, 2021. Jeffrey was born December 3, 1982 in Oklahoma City, the only son of Russell Rowell and Kathryn (Tooley) Tucker. He grew up in Lexington and attended school there, graduating with the Bulldog Class of 2001. Jeffrey was a friend to many, always seeing the good in others, that they sometimes couldn't see for themselves. He was gifted, well rounded, and a visionary. He was a proud father and he cherished his children; a wonderful son, brother, grandson, uncle and a true friend, who truly left his "mark on this world". Rest well Jeffrey!
