Jimmie Dale Tompkins, age 85 of Purcell, passed away Saturday July 19, 2025 at Oklahoma Heart Hospital South. Born February 1, 1940 in Maysville, OK, he was the younger of 2 children born to Martin 'Mart' Tompkins and Ruby L. (Allison) Tompkins. He was raised in Maysville and attended school there.
