Called Johnny by friends and family members, he was born on March 8, 1939 in Oklahoma City, to John and Julia Wilson. At the age of 15, Johnny moved with his family to the Lexington area. At 17, years he joined the U.S. Navy and was trained to operate airborne radar equipment on Navy WV 2 aircraft, flying from airbases in Barbers Point, Hawaii, Midway Island, Adak, Kodiak Alaska and Oceana Naval Air station at Virginia Beach, VA.
