



## Larry Dudgeon

May 26, 1949 - June 6, 2019

Larry Dudgeon age 70 of Lexington, passed away unexpectedly on Thursday, June 6, 2019 at his home. Lawrance Gene Dudgeon was born May 26, 1949, in Carnegie, Oklahoma. He was the seventh child of 13 children born to Raymond Emery Dudgeon and Pauline Florence (Dooley) Dudgeon. Larry learned how to work hard as a young boy and he kept that same work ethic throughout his life. He grew up in Cordell and graduated from Cordell High School with the class of 1967. After high school he was drafted into the U. S. Army and proudly served his country for nearly three years before being honorably discharged. While in the service he was stationed in Germany during the Vietnam War.

In 1998, Larry went to work for the University of Oklahoma and worked as an Electrical Technician, Mechanical Technician and Elevator Technician. He retired in 2010.
