Lee Carrier, age 74 of Newcastle, passed away Wednesday, February 9, 2022. Harold Lee Carrier Jr. was born March 7, 1947 in Fairview, OK, the middle child of three children born to Harold Sr. and Treva Carlene (Major) Carrier. His early years were spent in Fairview where he began school, and later Oklahoma City. Lee graduated from U.S. Grant Highschool with the Class of 1965. He then attended the University of Central Oklahoma for a time, all the while working some odd jobs whenever he could. Taking the advice of his father, Lee joined the United States Army and served his country during two tours in Vietnam. He was true patriot, and proud of his service.
