Lenora Hobbs, age 102 of Purcell, passed away peacefully Sunday, March 04, 2018, at Westbrook Gardens in Purcell. Lenora Bernice Fuson was born September 28, 1915, on the Chickasaw Reservation near Tishomingo, Oklahoma. She was the oldest of 10 children born to Thomas Cornelius Fuson and Agnes (Folsom) Fuson. Lenora began school in a one room school house named Cottonwood, later graduating with a Bachelor's Degree from MIT in Tishomingo. On September 24, 1938, Lenora married Lyman Hobbs II at the First Baptist Church in Tishomingo. In the mid 1940's, they settled in Purcell where together they raised two sons, Lyman III and John. Lenora worked as an accountant for McClain Bank in Purcell for many years. When not working, she stayed busy volunteering at the Purcell Hospital and at Central State Hospital in Norman. Lenora was a member of the Eastern Star and a longtime and a faithful, and the oldest living member of the Trinity United Methodist Church in Purcell. She was most proud of her Native American heritage, and an Elder in the Chickasaw Tribe. Lenora was a wonderful mother, grandmother, aunt and friend, who leaves a great legacy of faith, love and service to others. She will be dearly missed!
