



## Lewie Jeffries

July 22, 1940 - September 14, 2020

Lewie Jeffries, age 80 of Washington, passed away Monday, September 14, 2020. Lewie Junior Jeffries was born July 22, 1940 in Buckhannon, West Virginia, the 5th of 9 children born to Lewie Franklin Jeffries and Pearl Frances (Ware) Jeffries. He was raised in Buckhannon and attended school there. Still a young man, Lewie answered the call to serve and joined the United States Navy, and served peacefully during the Cuban Crisis. He stayed active in his community and served any way he could. His final public service was serving as President of the Washington Senior Citizens.
