Lyman Dwain Johns, age 91 of Purcell, passed away Wednesday, April 1, 2026. He was born April 10, 1934 in Rosedale, Oklahoma, the oldest of three sons born to Lonnie and Pearl (Boles) Johns. Raised in Rosedale and attending school there, he graduated with the Cardinals Class of 1952. Lyman answered the call to serve his country and joined the United States Army.
