Martin Edward Stack age 66 of Purcell, passed away Tuesday, April 21, 2015 at the Norman Specialty Hospital. Martin was born on July 24, 1948 in St. Louis, Missouri. He also grew up and attended school in Missouri. After his junior year of high school he was 17 years old when he joined the United States Army. While attended the center he has enjoyed playing dominoes and working puzzles. He is survived by his many friends at the Purcell senior citizens center.
