Martyne was born February 17, 1941 in Okla. City where she lived until age 6. In the Fall of 1947 the McMahan family moved to Newcastle where she attended both Newcastle and Bridge Creek Schools. She graduated from Newcastle High School with the class of 1959. After graduation Martyne attended Central State College for 2 years and later attended Business School in Okla City. In the late 60's Martyne moved to Mullinville, Kansas where her sister, Sue lived. While in Kansas she worked as a personal care giver in private homes and also in nursing homes. While working in Greensburg, Kansas she met Herbert Noland and they were married on November 24, 1972 in Okla. City. After they were married Martyne continued to work in the nursing home and also helped Herb run their service station. While in Kansas their son, Samuel was born in 1983. In 1987 they moved back to Okla. Where they lived in Moore until they moved to Geronimo in 1989. For the past 31 years Martyne and Herb have been part of the Geronimo community. When Sam joined Boy Scouts in 1st grade Martyne and Herb began their 30 year involvement with Scouts. Even after Sam was no longer a Scout, Martyne continued to be active with the organization. Over the years Martyne worked for the Geronimo School system and babysat for several children from infancy until they started school. Martyne was a member of the First Baptist Church of Geronimo. She
