Wuyona “Nonie” Mennetta Humeston, 91, passed away Saturday, November 2, 2024. Born September 2, 1933, Nonie was the second of four children born to James “Leonard” Jackson and Hazel (Cypert) Jackson. She grew up in Purcell, Oklahoma and graduated from Purcell High School.
