



## Orville Perry

October 13, 1926 - February 14, 2016

Longtime Noble resident, Orville "O.D." Perry, age 89 of Chickasha, passed away Sunday, February 14, 2016, surrounded by his family at home. Orville Duane Perry was born October 13, 1926 in Spencer, OK, the only child of Teddy Roosevelt Perry and Grace Louise (Boling) Perry. He was raised in the Arcadia and Spencer area and attended Star Schools. O.D. was drafted into the United States Army in May of 1945. He served his country proudly during World War II, and was honorably discharged in November of 1946. After his service, O.D. returned home to Oklahoma and married a young woman named Maxine Moore. They settled in Chickasha where together they raised a son, Duane and daughter, Alice. For most of his working life, O.D. worked as a self-employed dozer operator. His heart however, was always on the farm. He enjoyed spending his days working the land. O.D. later married Charlotte Wooden in October of 1979 and they settled in Noble. When not working, you could find O.D. somewhere playing his fiddle. Throughout the years, he sat it in with several area artist, and for more than 15 years, he fiddled at the Purcell Senior Citizen Dances. Fiddling was his life and his music brought him great joy.
