Tucker and Sally Beth (Pace) Tucker. She was raised in Purcell and attended school there, graduating with the Dragon's Class of 1977. By chance, she met a young man named Tony Christian just out about town, and the rest as they say is history. They were married on January 22, 1982 and the city girl moved to the farm. Together they raised two children, daughter Taylor and son Colby. Patti worked for Hi-Test, for the University of Oklahoma and at Harold's Clothing in 50 Penn Place. In 1992, she began working for the McClain County Conservation District, and was currently the District Secretary. In 2023 she was Oklahoma Conservation District Employee of the year. Away from work, she stayed active in her kids and grandkids activities, supporting them at ag contests and at ballgames.
