Pauline Craig Miller, age 96 of Wayne, passed away Monday, March 25, 2013 at the Lexington Nursing Home. Pauline was born September 6, 1916 in Purcell, the youngest of 3 children born to Woody Lee Craig and Alta Lee (Houser) Craig. She grew up in Wayne and attended Wayne Schools, graduating in 1934, and later attended the University of Oklahoma. Pauline married Brooke L. Wallace on June 26, 1941, and to this union, a daughter, Bettye and a son, Billy were born. Pauline taught at Wayne Schools for about 3 years and Brooke was the Wayne Postmaster.
