Randall Keith Fuller, age 73 of Noble, Oklahoma, passed away on Saturday, September 3, 2022. He was born January 27, 1949 in Durant, Oklahoma, the oldest of 3 children born to Henry Nolan Fuller Jr and Regina (Compton) Fuller. He was raised in Southeastern Oklahoma, and graduated from Capitol Hill High School in 1966. In 1971, Randall received his bachelor's degree in Education.
