Randy Lee Shobert, age 68, of Noble Oklahoma passed away Monday March 20, 2023. He was born on March 3, 1955 in Norman, Oklahoma. He was the youngest of 4 children born to this family. Randy grew up in Noble where he graduated with the Noble Bear class of 1973. On January 23, 1981 he married Patti Gayle Moss. He was a loyal and dedicated friend and employee. He worked for 25 years with the Department of Corrections where he was a K9 Correctional Officer. He would raise, train and handle track dogs. Randy's track dogs had a ninety-percentage apprehension record, which is the best in the state of Oklahoma. His dogs have assisted local and county police departments, as well as, the US Marshall's Office and the Federal Bureau of Investigation. He was a rose rock collector and continued the heritage of collecting, that was instilled in him by being raised around Shobert's Rose Rocks, which was owned and operated by his folks. Randy loved being outdoors and anything and everything to do with his farm and cattle. That was his happy place. Randy was a jack of all trades and there was nothing that he could not do. He built his own house and barns and was quite the woodworker. In memory of his nephew Matt, he built his sister Reta a cedar chest to keep memorabilia to remember him by. He was a man of great faith, and accepted Christ into his heart at a young age, and was a long time member of Maguire Baptist Church. Randy was an amazing man and will be dearly missed.

He was preceded in death by: wife, Patti Shobert; parents, Fred and Alma

(Minor) Shobert; brother, Dale Piper; brother-in-law, Pat Pattillo; and nephew, Matt Cottrell.
