Ray Stucks age 73 of Bridgecreek, Oklahoma passed unexpectedly on Monday, May 22, 2017 at St. Anthony Hospital in OKC. He was born June 25, 1943 in Pauls Valley, OK. Ray was the 3rd child of eight children born to Raymond Earl Stucks and Gladys Irene (Ivey) Stucks. While growing up he learned how to work hard as a young boy.
