Robert Austin "Bob" Mitchusson, age 75 of Purcell died Monday, October 29, 2012 at his home. He was born May 1, 1937 in Okla. City, the second child of Bill Murray Mitchusson and Rosa Lee Williams Mitchusson. He grew up in Okla. City graduating from Central High School in 1955.
