Wanda Booze age 80, of Oklahoma City, passed away Tuesday August 30, 2022 in Norman. Wanda Lou Klepper was born November 19, 1941 in Rosedale, Oklahoma, the oldest of 3 children born to Haskell William Klepper and Lucille Ida (Whitfield) Klepper. Wanda's early childhood years were in Rosedale, where she began school, before moving to Purcell in 1953. Wanda graduated with Honors from Purcell High School with the Dragon's Class of 1960. She then attended the University of Oklahoma, and graduated with a Bachelor's Degree in Science & Business Education in 1964. Wanda married her high school sweetheart, Raymond Booze, on April 10, 1964. They moved to Texas and settled near Denton, where together they raised three children, daughters, Cheryl and Christal and a son, Michael. Wanda worked side by side with Raymond in the day-to-day operations of the family business, Booze Appliance Service and Repair for more than 30 years. She later worked for Trinity Industries in Dallas for more than 10 years, before retiring in 1995. After retirement, she enjoyed her time as a volunteer for Norman Regional Hospital. She was an avid sports fan and yelled loud for her Sooners and the Dallas Cowboys. She was a gifted quilter and seamstress, and she shared her many talents with family and friends.
