Wes spent much of his adult life working for the railroad, where through dedication and perseverance he advanced to the position of conductor. Beyond his professional life, he faithfully volunteered with several churches and found great joy in serving others for God's glory.

Throughout his life, Wes faced many challenges, yet God carried him through each one. A devoted disciple, he led countless people to Christ throughout his life and remained faithful until his final breath. His love for his family and friends was unwavering, and he would have done anything for those he cared for.
