



Wyman Francis Ewing

April 15, 1932 - March 5, 2024

Dr. Wyman Ewing passed away peacefully on Wednesday, March 5, 2024 at the age of 91. He frequently said "I never thought I'd live this long". Those that knew him understood that he worked hard to remain healthy and active as he aged. Fitness was a part of his life for over 60 years. He was an avid outdoorsman, traveling into Canada and Alaska to hunt and fish and South America to catch peacock bass. After retirement he worked in home construction with a close friend, just to stay active. The only compensation he asked for was a lemonade. He made life-long friends wherever he went and as mentioned by his grandson "everybody likes him!" After a growing up in rural Oklahoma, he graduated from the University of Oklahoma 1954 and went on to Medical School at St. Louis University 1958. He completed Radiology Residency at University of Oklahoma and joined Pueblo Radiology in 1962. He worked with St. Mary Corwin Hospital and Pueblo Radiology until he retired in 1994, again in 1995 and finally in 1996. He then continued working in Tasmania, Australia fulfilling his love to travel and to have something to do. He married Doris Reynolds in 1954 and when he passed away they were a few short months away from their 70th anniversary. They raised three sons together, and then traveled the world choosing the uncommon places. They shared a love of Hawaii and spent time there as well as in Arizona and the Colorado mountains he loved. He was an active member of his church and he lived his faith every day. He taught and led to the best of his ability. He was always a member of the choir, but in his later

years, he developed a love of singing he had not known and became very active in the choir at his home in Surprise, AZ. He is survived by his wife, sons Dave (Crystal), Steve, and Jim (Crystie), seven grandchildren, and one great-grandchild. In his later years he frequently said that the thing he was most proud of in his life was his family. He will be greatly missed by all.
